

Half term break

This morning in assembly we wished all the children a very happy half term and also asked them to do the following during their time off school.

- 1. Read at least one book.
- 2. Practise some number work either counting, number bonds or timetables depending where they are in their learning.
- 3. Consider both the Loddon Code and our school Values so that they can show even better learning behaviour (being kind and considerate, good listening, trying their hardest in their learning) when we return next half term.

Your help in supporting your children with the above would be greatly appreciated.

Updated approach to reporting to parents/carers

This year we have updated some of our approaches to assessment and as part of this we are making some changes to the way we share assessment data with parents/carers. After careful thought we have taken the decision to discontinue the autumn and spring term report cards, previously issued to Y1-6.















The main reason for taking this decision, to cease report cards, is that more recently we have found an increasing number of families are unsure what the report card data actually means for their child and as a standalone document we have not been able to find any evidence that it positively influences your child's education. Indeed at worse it has become the source of a misunderstood picture of how your child is actually doing and created subsequent unnecessary anxiety for some families. We wish to share data with you positively and as part of a wider conversation about your child's education. The best vehicle for this is the two-way conversations that take place at parents' evening in both the autumn and spring terms.

As part of updating our approaches we will instead be introducing a new document which you will receive as part of your parents' evening appointment. This outlines curriculum and year group targets for your child. We hope this will help you to better understand the learning your child is expected to complete in their particular year group as well as giving you an idea of areas you might wish to work on together at home. Along with the recently issued 'Activity Passport' you will then have guidance around a number of activities and skills you can share with your child.

Finally, just to confirm, there are no planned changes to the formal end of year report for Y1-6 which will continue as before.

Phonics Information session

There will be a phonics information session on Friday 15th November in FSU hall from 9-9:45 for parents. The session is mostly aimed at Reception parents but we will cover how phonics progresses across the year groups from Nursery to Year Two.

Attendance is strongly recommended for Reception parents but other parents are also welcome to attend if they feel it would be beneficial.



Gardening Club

We have been busy creating this year's entry for the Newbury scarecrow competition - our mermaid Erwina-'Friend of the Sea'. She was taken to Newbury for judging Wednesday and was awarded a Special Commendation.
