

School Learning Platform

A reminder to all families that our school learning platform contains additional information for parents such as timetables, what the children will be studying in greater detail and recommended booklists. It also has a number of learning applications to support your child with practising basic skills. Some areas and applications require your child to use their individual log-in. If your child is unsure what this log-in is please speak to their class teacher who will help. If you wish to view general year group information and parent workshop presentations you may log-in as your child's year group FSU, y1, y2 etc. and password Loddon. The staff give as much time as they are able, around their other duties, to updating these areas for your use and are currently reviewing their pages for the new academic year so it is worth checking back again in the future to see which additional resources may have been added.



Loddon Primary School Library

Loddon Primary School Library aims to provide a welcoming environment that encourages and supports children by promoting the concept of reading for pleasure. A wide range of non-fiction books provides material to support both curriculum learning and the children's own hobbies and interests. The fiction collection contains a variety of popular books to encourage children at all levels of reading ability; ranging from picture books and quick reads through to chapter books and graphic novels.

Children are able to access the library to borrow books both as part of organised class visits and independently during break and lunchtime.

The library is open at the following times for the children to access the library independently:

- Year 2 Tuesday Lunchtime
- Year 3 Monday Break and Thursday Lunchtime
- Year 4 Tuesday Break and Friday Lunchtime
- Year 5/6 Thursday Break and Monday Lunchtime

Books are issued for two weeks and have a date stamped inside as a reminder as to when books are due to be returned to the library. Children can borrow one book at a time - Year 5-6 who can borrow two. There are no fines on overdue books but children are encouraged to return their book on time. This means they can then choose a new book to read themselves and the returned book is made available for another child to borrow. If a book is lost or damaged, we may ask for a contribution towards the cost of a replacement copy. Mrs Screene, Librarian
