### Value of the month - Thoughtfulness

During the month of January we will be looking at the value of 'Thoughtfulness'. We will be asking the children to think carefully about what 'Thoughtful' means and how they might be able to show 'Thoughtfulness' through their learning and friendships.

As usual we launched our value through assembly - Reception to Year 2 children thought about the importance of always using kind words and kind hands at school.

Year 3 -6 children explored, in their assembly, how they can be 'even more thoughtful'. Ideas included: Stopping to think carefully; pausing before you speak or act; taking time to decide; using your imagination to understand how others think; remembering to act kindly and doing good without being asked. We would appreciate if families could also take a few moments to revisit this thinking with their child at home.


#### Royal British Legion Poppy Appeal
