Monday 27th June: Year 2 (lunchtime), Year 5 and 6 (after school)


Tuesday 28th June: Year 4 (lunchtime), Year 5 and 6 (after school)

humour in the book! I am on the last book of the large collection"



Playleaders and Peer Mentors

Whilst at Loddon, children have many opportunities to fulfil different roles as part of our school community. In today's newsletter we will showcase some further roles held by children in our school.

Playleaders

Play Leaders are a group of Y5 children who have been trained to organise activities for other children on the playground. They encourage children to join in games and to extend their friendships. It is also a great opportunity for the Y5 children to develop their leadership and organisational skills. The playleaders support at morning break time and lunch time. They are responsible for opening up the PE sheds, setting up games, handing out equipment and ensuring everything is put away quickly and safely.

Peer-Mentors

A group of Y5 children completed training sessions based upon the Anna Freud Centre Peer Mentor Support programme. This enables the children to support other children through offering help and support, building emotional resilience, promoting wellbeing and positive mental health, and signposting to further support. The mentors are available during lunchtimes for children to approach them if they are having a friendship issue, worrying about something or feeling upset.

Parent course - 'Helping your child with English'

Every Tuesday for the next six weeks starting on Tuesday 21^{st} June 22 from 1.30 till 3.30pm in the Parent Hut. Duration of course 5-weeks running every Tuesday until 19^{th} July

Refresh and develop confidence in supporting your child with their learning and refresh your own English skills. Become familiar with key methods of teaching children to read and write including phonics. Learn easy activities to do at home to reinforce learning through games, songs, and stories. Aimed at parents with children KS1.
